HENDRA VIRUS DETECTED IN SOUTH-EAST QLD!

A recent case of Hendra virus in south-east Queensland has resulted in the death of an unvaccinated horse, Queensland's first confirmed case of the virus in three years.

Hendra virus is a rare but deadly disease transmitted from flying foxes to horses. Horses can then pass the infection onto humans. The virus can cause a range of symptoms in horses:

Usually there is a rapid onset of illness, fever, increased heart rate and rapid deterioration with respiratory and/or neurological (nervous system) signs. There is no vaccine for humans, but an effective vaccine is available for horses. Vaccination remains the most reliable protection against this disease.

We encourage all horse owners to vaccinate their animals and maintain good hygiene practices. These proactive steps help protect not only your horses but also the broader community.
