Why is pregnancy testing your herd important?

Rather than feeding an unproductive cow, she can be culled from the herd, leaving more available feed for the pregnant ones. Pregnancy testing also allows early detection of potential reproductive diseases that are prevalent in our area, such as Leptospirosis, Vibriosis and BVDV (Pestivirus). These diseases can result in a very low conception rate; hence early detection means it could save you huge losses!!

When should I get my herd pregnancy tested?

Ideally they should be tested at least 8 weeks after the bull has been removed from the herd and before the dry season, where pasture availability is low, meaning they lose condition and become less saleable.

At the time of Preg Testing we can vaccinate your pregnant females against reproductive diseases; ensuring peak productivity in your herd is achieved.
